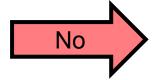

Did the information you are using come from a book, article, or website?

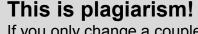


This is not plagiarism.

If the information did not originate from another source it is not considered plagiarism.

The information consists of your own original ideas, conclusions, or critiques.

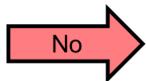
Plagiarism Checker



If you only change a couple words it is still considered plagiarism. You must paraphrase and then cite the original work.



Did you use (copy/paste) the words exactly (verbatim) from this source?

Did you alter or change some of the words from your original source or perhaps just shuffle the order of the words around?



This is not plagiarism.

If you have reviewed the information and used your own words (paraphrased) to detail what you have learned, then you have not committed plagiarism. Your sources *must* include <u>in-text</u> citations and a proper reference list.

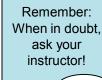


Did you use quotation marks and appropriate in-text citations?



This is plagiarism!

If you copy/pasted the information directly from a source, but do not use quotation marks or cite the source accordingly you are plagiarizing. If you are going to use the information directly (word for word) you must use quotation marks and include in-text citations and reference the work in APA Format.



This is not Plagiarism.

However, you will want to make sure your <u>in-text</u> <u>citations</u> are in proper <u>APA format</u>. You will also want to check with your instructor on how much of your assignment is allowed to be from direct quotes.
