Accessing your Digital Textbook

To access your Digital Textbook (eText) in your online class locate the Module called **VitalSource Digital Textbook**. Click on the Title of your textbook and you should be prompted to open your text in a new window.





The first time you access your Digital Textbook, you'll need to create an account by complete some basic information. You will see the following box appear.

Sampling an eTextbook

Before we can provide you with a sample copy of this title, the publisher needs a few pieces of information. After this one time process, you will be able to open the selected title, and your information will be provided to the publisher of this title, and any other complimentary titles you may request in the future.





Enter your email address and then a password to create an account and continue.

Bookshelf Once you have created your account, you will have access to your Digital Textbook and can use Bookshelf on any device.

When you access your Digital Textbook the first time, you may notice an "expiring soon" message. This is because you only have complimentary access during the Opt-Out/In period. If you do not wish to Opt-out of the Digital Textbook, simply do nothing and your expiration date will get updated for the full rental period and you will continue to have access to your book. (if you have problems accessing your book in the downloadable or mobile apps, simply go

back through your online course and open your Digital Textbook through the link and the date will be set.)

If you decide to Opt-Out of using the Digital Textbook you will be responsible for purchasing the required materials for your class and the cost may be significantly higher. The course materials are required to help you succeed in this class.
